Comprehensive COOP Review

The COOP is coming! This class is for students entering 8th grade and applying to Catholic high schools.

For Mathematics

Ms. P. Prucnel

This course will provide extensive review in the mathematical section only of the COOP exam. In addition to reviewing arithmetic, number theory and problem solving, students will measure academic achievement through sample practice tests given in class.

For Reading and Language

Ms. P. Prucnel

This course is designed to provide instruction and review in reading and language arts, in preparation for the COOP exam. Sample exams in these areas will be reviewed to help measure academic achievement and aptitude.

Color and Design

Greek Vases Amphora

Magic in the Laboratory

Explore the physical world around you with hands on laboratory experiments in biology, chemistry and physics, such as: isolate DNA, discover the lifting power of helium, create colorful red, purple and green flames, change copper pennies into



“gold” and change white carnations to multicolored without touching a petal! Students will use computer technology in a Chemistry scavenger hunt for unusual elements and make the invisible ink used in *National Treasure!*

CSI: Crime Scene Investigation

Introduction to forensic science; complete hands on activities such as fingerprinting, foot prints, crime scene details. We will use various websites and play the game of CLUE.

Fun with Physics

Students will explore Physics through various experiments and demos, such as how to build a simple electric motor, building electrical circuits, making electricity from a lemon and measuring your speed. Conduct water balloon and egg shuttle experiments and much, much more.

After making collective decisions about editing and scoring the film, there will be a final screening for family and friends. A hands-on, fun and educational learning experience about the largest film industry in the world which will give expression to students' creativity.
