The exam consists of 4 sections:

- Writing: 10 short responses and one paragraph related to any of the topics mentioned below.
- Vocabulary and Grammar

Students should prepare by studying the following topics and grammatical content:

Themes and vocabulary

1. Greetings.
2. Asking someone's name and telling your name.
3. Expressions to talk about the weather.
4. Expressions of time, the days of the week, the months, the seasons.
5. Telling time.
6. How to tell someone's age.
7. Numbers (cardinal and ordinal numbers up to 100).
8. Dates.
9. Most common colors.
10. Classroom furniture.
11. Members of the family.
12. Rooms in the house.
13. Furniture of the house.
14. Buildings and places in the town such as gare, église, hôpital ...
15. Most common clothing.
16. Names of common foods, vegetables and fruits.

Verbs and structures

1. Tenses: present and imperative of all common —er, -ir, -re verbs and the irregular verbs: être, avoir, aller, faire.
2. Near future (futur immédiat): aller + infinitive.
3. Definite and indefinite articles, elision (l'), and contractions (au, aux, du, des).
4. Demonstrative adjectives and Possessive adjectives.
